The appointed candidate is expected to teach finance and investment courses for both undergraduate and postgraduate programmes; supervise honours projects; conduct experiential learning, including, but not limited to, internships and study tours in the Greater Bay Area; and support programme administrative work. Experience in tertiary teaching is essential.

Applicants should possess a Doctoral Degree in business studies, financial studies or related disciplines, along with a minimum of four years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience. Evidence of high-quality teaching at the tertiary level is also required. Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or a qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or another qualification of equivalent. Candidates with postgraduate teaching experience are particularly encouraged to apply.
