The appointee will join a large-scale research project focusing on entrepreneurial leadership, teacher entrepreneurialism, school networking, and capacity building across the Asia Pacific region. The project examines the impact of entrepreneurship education, cross-school and cross-sector collaboration, and leadership development in higher education and senior secondary school contexts.

The appointee will provide research and administrative support for a multifaceted and large-scale project. Responsibilities will include conducting literature reviews, assisting with data collection and quantitative analysis, coordinating with different units within the University and external partners, and drafting research reports and project documents. The appointee will also provide one-stop administrative support to facilitate the smooth implementation of project activities.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree or above, preferably with several years of post-qualification working experience in tertiary institutions or research projects.

They should have excellent command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese and Putonghua); good management and interpersonal skills; and be attentive to details. Experience with quantitative methods and data analysis is essential. Familiarity with various statistical software tools such as SPSS, R and/or Mplus will be considered a plus.
