We are seeking two motivated Research Assistants (RAII) to support a research project focused on financial literacy and AI application in Finance. The role will involve conducting literature reviews, collecting and analyzing quantitative data, assisting in stakeholder engagement, and contributing to the preparation of research reports and policy recommendations.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to candidates with a Master's degree in business-related fields. The ideal candidate will have a strong interest in finance and/or economics, along with the ability to work effectively in a dynamic academic environment. Preferred qualifications include familiarity with economic policy/regulation and/or financial education, demonstrated analytical and research skills, proficiency in both English and Mandarin.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
