The appointee will provide support to the learning and teaching project titled “Redesigning learning outcomes and assessments in the era of generative AI: Evidenced-based authentic examples, innovation and capacity building”. He/She will be responsible for conducting research and development in human-AI collaboration and assessment design in the age of AI. The appointee will assist in conducting research activities including literature review, data collection, analysis, publication of findings in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, books/chapters, and reports; undertaking research project/programme in collaboration with the supervisor(s) and their research teams and research postgraduate students; and presenting findings in conferences, seminars, meetings, and knowledge transfer occasions; and performing any other research-related duties as assigned by the supervisor(s) and/or his/her delegate(s). The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months, subject to renewal based on performance.

Applicants should have a PhD in Education or a related discipline. Research experience in the area of AI in education and/or assessment will be advantageous. They should have an excellent command of both written and spoken English and Chinese; be attentive to details; and with good interpersonal and communication skills. Applicants should also be self-motivated and able to work independently or as a good team player.
