Applications are invited for the position of Research Assistant I to support an Early Career Scheme (ECS) project entitled “From Analytics to Actions: Enhancing Feedback Practices in Inquiry-based Discussion through Prescriptive Network Analysis”. The project explores how learning analytics and AI-supported approaches can be used to understand and enhance feedback practices in inquiry-based discussions. The appointment will be for 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to satisfactory performance and project needs.

The appointee will assist with project-related research and development activities, including developing research tools or demo systems, processing and analysing learning data, supporting classroom or online studies, preparing research reports and manuscripts, assisting with project administration, coordinating with student helpers and participants, and performing other duties assigned by the project leader.

Applicants with a Bachelor’s degree or above in education, technology, data science, or related disciplines are welcome to apply. Relevant experience or interest in learning analytics, AI in education, collaborative learning, or educational research would be an advantage.

We particularly welcome candidates who are self-motivated, responsible, willing to learn, and able to work both independently and collaboratively. Good communication and organisational skills would be helpful. Familiarity with data analysis, programming, or research software would be beneficial but not essential. Training and guidance will be provided where appropriate.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
