Specific duties include preparing research materials, data collection, data coding, data analysis, report writing, and supervision of student helpers. The appointee is also expected to perform administrative support to the Principal Investigator and the research team. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal, subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a PhD Degree in Psychology or a relevant discipline. Applicants should be competent in academic research, detail-oriented, responsible, and independent. Proficiency in statistical analyses (e.g., SPSS, R, or other data-analysis software) is essential. Proficiency in big-data analyses (e.g., machine learning) and programming will be a great asset. The applicants should have an excellent command of both written and spoken English and Chinese. Immediate availability is preferred.
