The appointee(s) will join a research team to support multidisciplinary research projects involving the scientific evaluation of community sports programmes. He/She will support project administration and management, including coordination of training courses, activities, scheduling, and progress monitoring. The appointee(s) will also conduct research activities such as participant recruitment, data collection (fitness assessments, surveys, interviews), data processing, and data analysis, as well as assist in preparing progress reports, funding claims, and research deliverables. Working on weekday evenings or weekends may be required. The appointee(s) will also be occasionally required to perform any other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree or above in Event Management, Health Psychology, Sports Science, Physical Education, or a related sports discipline. Previous research experience (e.g., data collection, literature review, or data analysis) will be an advantage. Self-motivated, responsible, and organised candidates who are able to work independently and as part of a team are preferred. Good command of written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese) is a must because of the nature of the community engagement and research context.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
