The appointees will provide support to research projects that develop and evaluate science and robotics education innovations, including educational robots and AI tools for elderly users, Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) students and primary school learners, and online school STEM curriculum development. He/she will be responsible for leading high-quality academic publications, coordinating cross-institutional collaborations, mentoring research assistants and postgraduate students, preparing external grant applications and research proposals, and organising academic seminars and workshops. He/She will handle administrative tasks and undertake other duties assigned by the Principal Investigator or his/her delegate(s).

Applicants should have a doctoral degree preferably in science education, robotics education, engineering education, educational technology Psychology, Computer Science, Robotics Engineering or related disciplines. Research experience in science and/or robotics education, educational technology, speech therapy or STEM education are advantageous. Candidates with an interest in entrepreneurship, intellectual property commercialisation and technology transfer are preferred. Prospective applicants should exhibit proficiency in both written and spoken English and Chinese. They should be capable of working independently and under pressure while possessing strong interpersonal and organizational skills.
