

## **Multimedia Developer (Ref: 2600411)** **Faculty of Education and Human Development**

The appointee should be familiar with cutting-edge technologies (e.g. AI, web, mobile applications, VR, AR, or MR) and contribute to AI-integrated pedagogical innovation in the Faculty. The appointee will support the development of digital learning resources and other multimedia productions, including on-site photo and video shooting, image editing, post-production, and animation. He/She will work closely with the team to design and develop digital learning resources that incorporate creative and innovative approaches to learning and teaching, with a particular emphasis on the effective integration of AI in education. This includes applying AI tools (such as generative AI for text, image, and video production) to enrich teaching materials, and helping to translate teaching ideas into engaging, technology-supported learning experiences. He/She will also support the Faculty in maintaining the Innovation Hub on the Faculty website for sharing learning and teaching resources and good practices, and provide technical and administrative support to Faculty projects.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably with several years of hands-on working experience in multimedia production, web design, e-learning, or related areas, preferably in tertiary institutions. A background in education will be advantageous. They should possess a high level of proficiency in English and Chinese; demonstrate practical experience in using AI tools for content development and have a clear understanding of how digital and AI technologies can be applied in learning and teaching contexts; strong skills in multimedia production (e.g. Adobe Creative Cloud); have experience with LMS platforms and e-learning authoring tools and technologies; be innovative and possess a good artistic sense; and demonstrate strong problem-solving, communication, project management, and organisational skills. Immediate availability is preferred. Applicants with less experience will be considered for the post of Project Assistant. The initial appointment will be for a period of two years, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits. The appointee will hold a substantive rank of Project Officer / Project Assistant in the University.
