

**Research Assistant I (Ref: 2600423)  
Integrated Centre for Wellbeing**

**[Appointment Period: 12 months]**

The appointee will provide research and technical support for various artificial intelligence (AI) and technology-driven projects within the Integrated Centre for Wellbeing (I-WELL) at The Education University of Hong Kong. The role focuses heavily on the development and maintenance of AI-based educational technology applications, including feature development and debugging, technical testing, and quality assurance, as well as regular system updates and maintenance. Key responsibilities also include recruiting and communicating with potential participants, schools, and community partners, supporting internal and external communications related to project implementation, and contributing to product dissemination and user training activities. He/She will also be responsible for collecting and analyzing data from participants, coordinating, report writing and rolling out the implementation of various technological interventions, and providing administrative and logistical support for the projects. The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to agreement and satisfactory performance.

Applicants should have a bachelor's degree or higher in education, psychology, special education, information technology, computer science, software engineering, or a related field. Experience with technology projects, particularly in the context of educational technology, AI integration, or ergonomic systems, would be considered an advantage. The candidate should possess strong technical skills in AI and software development, demonstrate attention to detail, and have a genuine interest in educational technology. Demonstrated experience in conducting educational or psychological research, including data collection, analysis, and reporting, is essential. Strong IT skills, including proficiency in the Microsoft Office suite, are necessary. Strong analytical and problem-solving skills, excellent written and verbal communication skills in both English and Chinese, and the ability to work collaboratively in a team environment are also required.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
