Applicants should possess a doctoral degree and preferably have at least four years of post-master's teaching experience in a tertiary education setting. Preference will be given to applicants with qualified teacher status and/or professional qualifications in Environmental Science, Pedagogy, Sustainability, STEM, or a closely related discipline. Applicants should be able to demonstrate a strong record of high-quality teaching in both undergraduate and postgraduate programmes and/or possess proven, relevant professional experience at the tertiary level. Applicants with international experience will be highly valued.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave, medical and dental benefits.
