The appointee will be responsible for providing administrative and research support to the project team. He/she will assist in (i) refining research instruments; (ii) supporting and monitoring data collection; (iii) assisting with the conduct of teacher and student focus group interviews; (iv) transcribing, cleaning, and analyzing data under the PI's supervision; and (v) undertaking other project-related tasks as assigned by the PI.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably have a bachelor's degree in Chinese language studies, Chinese as a second language, or Language education. Experience in academic institutions is preferred. A higher degree (e.g., Master's) will be an advantage. Applicants should be proficient in English, Mandarin, and/or Cantonese. He/she should have strong organizational and coordination skills, proficiency with computer applications, and, preferably, experience in data collection and application of artificial intelligence (AI) tools in educational settings. He/she should be able to work independently, be detail-oriented, and manage multiple tasks and deadlines effectively.
