The Department of Curriculum and Instruction, Faculty of Education and Human Development, at The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) invites applications for a Research Assistant / Senior Research Assistant position to support a series of research projects in higher education, learning sciences, and educational innovation.

The project addresses key challenges in higher education, particularly in large-class teaching and learning. It explores how interdisciplinary approaches can enhance learning quality, engagement, and student development across diverse educational contexts. The research broadly focuses on areas including learning environment design, AI and technology-enhanced learning, learner and professional development, and feedback processes in education. A range of methodological approaches will be adopted, including quantitative, qualitative, and design-oriented methods, to support evidence-based innovation in teaching and learning.

Applicants for the Research Assistant I position should hold a Bachelor's degree in Education, Educational Psychology, Learning Sciences, or a related discipline, with basic knowledge of quantitative and/or qualitative research methods. Experience in data collection, analysis and writing is expected. A good command of written and spoken English is required, with proficiency in Chinese desirable. Applicants should be able to work both independently and collaboratively.

Applicants for the Senior Research Assistant position should possess a Master's degree (or above) in a relevant field, with one-year post-Master's full-time work experience or a doctoral degree. They should demonstrate experience in research design and implementation, and competence in quantitative and/or qualitative methods. Evidence of academic writing, including publications or contributions to peer-reviewed outputs, is preferred. Familiarity with the Hong Kong education system or related contexts will be an advantage.

For both levels, preference will be given to candidates with knowledge of learning environment design, AI in education or learning analytics, learner development (e.g., engagement, self-directed learning), and feedback processes in education. Experience in scale development and strong organisational and communication skills are desirable. Applicants should demonstrate the ability to work both independently with initiative and effectively as part of a collaborative research team.
