The appointee will be responsible for assisting the principal investigator in a research project titled “Reevaluating, Reimagining and Renegotiating the Global AI Power Dynamics by Chinese and Global AI Practitioners: A Mixed Method Approach”. This study aims at examining the following questions: How do Chinese and American AI practitioners reimagine the global impact of Chinese AI? Who holds the power to reimagine and renegotiate Sino-US AI power dynamics? And how will these imaginations reshape the global AI ecosystem? These questions are crucial for decision-makers, practitioners, and citizens as they explore, evaluate, and shape future paths—paths that could lead human society toward utopia, dystopia, or a complex blend of both.

The appointee will assist the qualitative and computational data collection and analysis, literature review, website and promotion activity management; and carrying out any other duties as assigned by the principal investigator. Applicants should have Bachelor’s degree or preferably Master’s degree in relevant social sciences disciplines (e.g., Communication and Media Studies; Information Studies; Science and Technology Studies, Sociology, Business Management, Anthropology or Cultural Studies). Prior research experience in relevant disciplines and prior working experiences in AI or technology industry are preferred. They are expected to have relevant research skills (e.g., qualitative interviews and computational data collection). They should be creative, self-motivated, responsible, organized, good at interpersonal communication. The appointment will be for a period of 6 months.
