The appointee will be responsible for providing support to a diverse project team led by the Principal Investigator, Prof. Li Hui. He/She will receive training and supervision while assisting with: (a) managing the project's and center's official social media platforms, website updates, and community engagement; (b) designing promotional materials, posters, and creative visual content (e.g., via Photoshop, Canva, or other design tools) to disseminate academic research findings and center affairs; (c) contributing to the research project, including the preparation of manuscripts, reports, and presentation materials; (d) assisting in the development and content creation for the project's digital platform demo; and (e) performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 1 year, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree, in Education, Psychology, Neuroscience, Digital Media, Communication, or a related discipline. He/She should have proven experience in social media operation, graphic design, or multimedia content creation, alongside a strong aesthetic sense. They are expected to possess a good work ethic, excellent communication and interpersonal skills, the ability to work independently with initiative and under pressure, a strong sense of responsibility, and proficiency in spoken and written English and Chinese.
