The appointee will assist the Principal Investigator with his/her research project funded by the SCOLAR, such as conducting literature reviews, preparing and analysing both quantitative and qualitative data, drafting summaries of initial findings, preparing for conference presentations and publications, and supporting the write-up reports. He/She will also help with administrative duties, such as assisting in teaching-related tasks, overseeing student helpers, planning and coordinating academic activities, and any other duties as assigned. The initial appointment will be for a period of around 12 months. Immediate availability will be an advantage.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree in modern Chinese literature, language education or a related major and several years of working experience. They should be highly proficient in both Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua) and English, attentive to fine details, self-motivated, able to work under tight timeline, and have good communication skills. Preference will be given to those with experience in large-scale research projects on Chinese literature or language education. Those who are familiar with Hong Kong literature would have an added advantage.
