The appointee will be responsible for providing research support to research program(s)/project(s); assisting in the application for potential overseas or local grants, writing up of research/project proposals; conducting research activities including data collection, analysis, publication of findings in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, books/chapters, and reports; undertaking research project/programme of research work in collaboration with the supervisor(s) and their research teams and research postgraduate students; and presenting findings in conferences, seminars, meetings, and knowledge transfer occasions; and performing any other research-related duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator and or his/her delegate(s). The appointment will be for 6 months with possibility for contract renewal.

Applicants should have a PhD in Psychology or a related discipline which specializing in vocational or occupational areas. Experience in working with adult workers and publication records in the same area are advantages. They should have sound experience with qualitative and/or quantitative methodologies, and knowledge in statistical analysis. Applicants should have an excellent command of both written English and Chinese, proficiency in spoken Cantonese. They should also be self-motivated, well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, be able to work independently and collectively as a good team member, and the ability to work under pressure.
