The appointee will be supervised by Dr Soyoung Lee to work on a research project on postdoctoral researchers and system in Hong Kong, South Korea, and UK higher education. The appointee will provide support to the research team and perform research activities independently. Research experiences in recruiting participants in HK, conducting interviews with academics or students in higher education, and managing qualitative data are highly desirable. The appointment will be for 10 months maximum.

Applicants should have at least a bachelor's degree, preferably a master's degree in education or a related discipline, with solid knowledge/experience of the higher education structure in Hong Kong. They should also possess good communication skills. A high level of proficiency in both spoken and written English and/or Chinese is required. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
