A Research Assistant I position is vacant in the Department of English Language Education. The successful candidate will provide research support to the project 'Linguistic and social practices in the training and recruitment of migrant domestic workers: An applied linguistics approach', which is funded by the Research Grants Council. He/she will interview migrant domestic workers and subsequently transcribe and translate the interviews. He/she will also do coding of data and be part of the initial data analysis. Other research-related work duties might also be included.

The successful candidate must be fluent in spoken and written Bahasa Indonesia and English and should have an undergraduate degree in applied linguistics, psychology, anthropology, or a related discipline. The ideal candidate should also have some relevant research-related work experience. An MA in a relevant discipline is an advantage but not a requirement. The initial appointment period is for 12 months with the possibility of extension.
