The Department of Cultural and Creative Arts is seeking a qualified, highly dedicated individual to support the department's capacity-building in creative arts research and enhance its academic profile.

The appointee will play a strategic role in grant bid development, research impact building, and Knowledge Exchange (KE). Key duties include facilitating competitive research grant applications, coordinating peer mentorship for early-career researchers, documenting practice-based creative outputs for research assessment, and organizing high-profile research symposia. The successful candidate will also contribute to student research supervision and teaching at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Applicants should possess an earned doctoral degree in creative arts, arts education, or a related discipline, together with a strong record of scholarship, evidence of relevant research outputs, and substantial research experience. The appointee should be proficient in English, self-motivated, and capable of working effectively under tight deadlines.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
