Project Title: Research Project on Math and Language Learning
[Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will work for a project on math and language learning incorporating brain signals and quantitative behavioral indicators as measurements. He/She will assist Principal Investigator to design electroencephalography (EEG) experimental tasks, collect EEG data from participants, conduct literature review, perform statistical analysis, and prepare manuscripts and progress reports. He/She will be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. The appointment will be for a period of 6 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to funding availability and satisfactory performance.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a recognized Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree in Educational Technology, Educational Neuroscience and Experimental Psychology related areas, with relevant research or work experience. They should have good command of written English, and spoken English and Chinese; proficiency in quantitative data processing and analysis (e.g., R, MATLAB, Python); strong interpersonal and communication skills, and the ability to work independently and as a team. Preference will be given to those who have experience in conducting EEG experiments.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
