The appointee will support the team's project operations and community engagement efforts. Key responsibilities include assisting in the planning, coordination, and execution of project activities, such as preventive publicity and education sessions; engaging with community members, organizations, and stakeholders through meetings, focus groups, and workshops to identify needs and foster collaboration; maintaining accurate documentation of project activities and client interactions while ensuring compliance with confidentiality and data protection regulations; preparing regular reports on project status, outcomes, and challenges; participating in the evaluation of project outcomes and impact by collecting and analyzing data, preparing evaluation reports, and making recommendations for program improvement; and performing other duties as assigned by the supervisor. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Applicants should hold at least a Bachelor's degree in social work or a related field. Preference will be given to those who are registered and licensed social workers in Hong Kong, with experience in project implementation, program management, community development, social services for ethnically diverse communities, or drug rehabilitation. Candidates must demonstrate strong teamwork skills with multidisciplinary groups, community stakeholders, and partner organizations. Proficiency in ethnic minority languages is highly desirable.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits. The appointee will hold a substantive rank of Project Officer in the University.
