The appointee will be responsible for providing support to a diverse project team led by the Principal Investigator, Prof. Li Hui. He/She will receive training and supervision while assisting with: (a) conducting comprehensive research tasks, including planning and carrying out data collection, literature reviews, and data analysis; (b) contributing to manuscript writing, report preparation, and presentation design for academic dissemination; (c) providing administrative and operational support to the supervisor and the research team; and (d) performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 1 year, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Master's degree, preferably in Social Science, Psychology, Education or related disciplines, plus one-year's post Master's Degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral degree. They are expected to possess a good work ethic, excellent communication and interpersonal skills, the ability to work independently with initiative and under pressure, a strong sense of responsibility, and proficiency in spoken and written English and Chinese.
