The appointee will be responsible for assisting the principal investigator and co-investigators in a research project titled “Teacher Image on Social Media: Investigating Teachers’ Self-Presentation and Construction of Professional Identity on Social Media Platforms”. This study aims to explore how teachers construct their professional identity on social media and the interplay between personal and professional personas across various platforms.

Applicants should have a Bachelor’s or preferably a Master’s degree in a relevant social sciences discipline (e.g., Communication and Media Studies, Education Studies, Psychology, Sociology, or Anthropology). The appointee will assist in qualitative and quantitative data collection and analysis, conduct literature reviews, and carry out any other duties as assigned by the principal investigator and co-investigators. Applicants should be familiar with qualitative and quantitative research skills. Excellent communication skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese are essential. Candidates should have good organizational and interpersonal skills, the ability to work independently, and meticulous attention to detail. A high level of self-motivation, patience, and a strong sense of responsibility are required.
