The appointee will provide comprehensive administrative and technical support to the Project Investigators in the execution of a Knowledge Transfer Pilot Project. The project aims at advancing digital humanities and serves as a strategic launch for EdUHK's SHAPE (Social Sciences, Humanities & the Arts for People and the Economy) initiative. The appointee will mainly support Project Investigators in conducting research for the project and in supporting the technology development work for the pilot project.

The job duties include but are not limited to supporting technical development tasks for the pilot project, such as providing technical support for prototype development, UI/UX optimization, UI/UX enhancements and validation; providing technical preparation for developing the cross-sector collaboration platform; supporting research activities such as data collection, analysis, and summaries; coordinating with internal and external parties; and undertaking any other duties assigned by the PIs. The successful applicants will have an appointment duration of 18 months.

Applicants should possess at least a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree, in Humanity or Computer Science, and have a minimum of two years' experience working as a Research Assistant. Applicants with experience related to AI model implementation are desirable. Strong editorial skills will also be an advantage. Applicants should have proficiency in English and Chinese (including Cantonese and Putonghua), strong attention to detail, self-motivation, excellent communication and organisational skills, and the ability to work effectively both independently and as part of a team.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
