Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably with several years of post-qualification working experience in tertiary institutions. Those with solid research support experience are highly desirable. They should be proficient in written and spoken English and Chinese (including Putonghua), and possess strong interpersonal, time management, organisational and IT skills. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, self-motivated and able to work under strict timelines.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
