We are seeking a Research Assistant for an 8-month appointment to work on the project “AI-enhanced Creative Pedagogy for Prospective Teachers: Cultivating Future Creative Educators Through Digital Storytelling”. This project will examine how AI-enhanced digital storytelling (DST) influences prospective teachers’ creativity, creative teaching self-efficacy and engagement.

Key responsibilities include:

- 1) Assist in the implementation of an AI-enhanced digital storytelling project for prospective teachers
- 2) Collect, manage, and analyze quantitative and qualitative data
- 3) Support the preparation and dissemination of research reports, presentations, and project deliverables

Qualification:

- At least Level 2 or equivalent or above in 5 subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in the HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in 5 subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent.
- Excellent communication skills in English (both written and spoken) and Chinese (Cantonese) are essential.
- Preference will be given to applicants with a bachelor’s degree or higher, preferably in the area of Social Science or Creative Arts.
- Experience in qualitative and quantitative research methodologies and/or relevant research experience in Creative and Digital Arts or Educational Technology will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
