Project Title: The Artificial Intelligence and Digital Competency Strategy for Innovation and Education Futures

The appointee will be responsible for providing research and coordination support for a large-scale artificial intelligence (AI) and digital competency project. Duties include conducting literature review on AI in education, developing and validating research instruments; conducting quantitative and qualitative data analysis; writing academic papers and reports on AI in education; as well as performing other duties assigned by the project principal investigator and his/her delegates. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal, subject to performance and mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree in Artificial Intelligence, Educational Technology, Computer Science, Data Science, Engineering, Psychology, and/or related disciplines, plus one-year post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral Degree.

Applicants should have an excellent command of written English and Chinese, high capability of conducting statistical analysis, and writing academic papers and reports independently. A sound background in statistics and experience in using statistical packages such as SPSS and R, are advantageous. They should be self-motivated and able to work as a team member. Applicants with academic background and research experience in related fields would be preferable. Immediate availability is preferred.
