The appointee will be responsible for supporting research projects. He/she will be responsible for assisting in the works of research projects relating to cognitive screening, physical activity in older adults, developing research materials, conducting literature review, assisting in the coordination and administrative work of the project, implementing intervention, supporting fitness test, fNIRS data collection within/outside campus and data analysis, writing papers/ reports, and performing any other duties assigned by the Project Leader or his/her delegate(s). The initial appointment will be for a period of around 12 months.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Physical Education, sports science or related fields, or related disciplines. Experience in multi-method such as behavioral and neuroscience in research or in physical activity intervention in middle-aged and older adults are advantages. They should also have a good command of written Chinese and English, a good command of Cantonese, as well as be conversant in English; have good interpersonal skills and organizational skills.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
