The Department of Literature and Cultural Studies is seeking suitable candidates to work on full-time basis to assist the project leader in the research project – “The Eight-legged Essay and the Development of Structure in Chuanqi Drama in the Late Ming Dynasty”. The primary duties include carrying out general administrative duties, collecting and transcribing data, conducting literature reviews, and liaising with internal and external members for academic / research issues. The appointee is expected to assume duty as soon as possible, and the appointment will be for a period of 2.5 months.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects, including Chinese Language, English Language, and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects, including Chinese, English (Syllabus B), and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to those with a Bachelor Degree or higher in Chinese Literature and Culture. They should have strong communication and interpersonal skills, and an excellent command of written and spoken Chinese (including fluent Putonghua) and English, a commitment to research, and strong administrative skills in project coordination. They should have good organizational and problem-solving skills; computer literacy; and be able to work independently and under pressure.
