The appointee will provide research and administrative support to the Principal Investigator (PI) and Distinguished Honorary Professor of the Academician Scheme in the field of Translational Biomedical Research. He/She is expected to support the scheme to broaden local primary and secondary school STEAM education in science. The appointee will conduct relevant research, and perform any other duties assigned by the supervisor. Collaboration with scholars from local and international universities may also be required.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree or above, with related research experience. They should have excellent communication skills and have high proficiency in written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese) and be able to work independently. Occasional business trips to mainland China and overseas are required, including weekends and public holidays.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
