For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should hold a Bachelor's degree, preferably in Sociology, Psychology, Communication, Education, Social Sciences, or a related discipline. Possessing a Master's degree would be considered an advantage. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. They should be research-oriented, with experience in qualitative research analysis. Strong writing skills in both Chinese and English are essential. The applicants should also be self-motivated, able to work independently as well as collaboratively.
