We are seeking a highly qualified Post-doctoral Fellow to join our research team and taking a leading role in a programme of research on mental health, family relationship, and lifespan development. The successful candidate will work under the supervision of the Co-Investigator, Prof Jiang Da, and collaborate with a diverse team of other Co-PIs and researchers. The appointee will support the on-going projects of the PI and independently design, conduct and disseminate research on aging and mental health, including study development, data collection and analysis, and preparation of publications and project reports. The appointee will also assist in supervising postgraduate students and research assistants, contribute to grant applications and knowledge transfer/impact-oriented projects, and be engaged in some teaching activities, including undergraduate and postgraduate psychology courses. The appointee may be required to perform other duties assigned by the Principal Investigator. The appointment will be for a period of 8 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have obtained a doctoral degree in Psychology, Social Science, or Public Health, or related field and preferably have relevant full-time post-qualification experience. Applicants should have a coherent research track record in sleep and psychology, including at least one first-authored article published or accepted for publication in a top-quartile (Q1) journal in the field of mental health research.

Applicants should demonstrate independent research ability, data-analytic skills, and research leadership. Excellent communication skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese are essential. Candidates should possess strong management and interpersonal abilities, demonstrate the capacity to work independently, and exhibit meticulous attention to detail. A high level of self-motivation, patience, and a strong sense of responsibility are required.
