The appointment will be for a period of 8 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology or a related discipline, along with relevant post-qualification working experience, and be detail-oriented. He/She should be proficient in both Chinese and English. He/She should be familiar with computer applications (e.g., Word, Excel and PowerPoint) and AI tools, and capable of working independently and multitasking effectively. Strong connections with kindergartens and primary schools would be an advantage. Immediate availability is preferred.
