The appointee will support a research and development project on social robotics in education. Responsibilities include conducting literature reviews; developing, organizing and delivering professional development activities and school engagement activities, including workshops and seminars; and liaising with teachers, schools, and other stakeholders. The appointee will also perform other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator or their delegate(s).

Applicants should have a Master's degree in Education, Psychology, Language Studies, or a related discipline, plus at least one year of relevant full-time post-qualification experience; or a doctoral degree. Teaching qualifications or experience in teaching English, Primary Humanities, or Primary Science in local primary schools are highly preferred. They should be familiar with Hong Kong's primary and kindergarten education systems.

Applicants should possess strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills and be able to work independently under pressure. Proficiency in written and spoken English and Chinese, including Cantonese and Putonghua, is required. Experience in educational technology, robotics, or applied research would be an advantage. Applicants with an interest in entrepreneurship and pursuing doctoral studies are preferred.
