The appointee will be responsible for supporting research projects. Specific duties include assisting in literature searches and reviews, analyzing survey and interview data, writing reports, managing administrative tasks, supervising other research assistants and student helpers, and performing additional duties as assigned by the project leader. The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should hold a doctoral degree in Education, Psychology, or other relevant fields. Previous experience with advanced qualitative and quantitative research software (e.g., Mplus, R, PLS, NVivo, SPSS) is preferred. Proficiency in both written and spoken English and Chinese is required, along with self-motivation and a willingness to learn new tasks. Experience in performing EEG, MEG, or MRI/fMRI is advantageous. Knowledge and skills related to advanced statistical modeling will also be considered an advantage. Shortlisted candidates may be invited to participate in a written test.
