Dean of the Faculty of Humanities

Reporting to Vice President (Academic) and Provost of the University, the Dean of the Faculty of Humanities is responsible for the dynamic and innovative leadership and management of the Faculty. He/She is a member of the Senior Management Committee who will foster excellence in teaching and learning, research and external relationships in accordance with the University's vision, mission and strategic plan, and will be responsible for ensuring high standards, consistent with international best practice. Specifically, he/she will:

- contribute to the strategic and academic planning, policy development and leadership of the University, and work collaboratively with other faculties and offices;
- provide effective leadership and direction in strategic and academic planning, policy development as well as research and scholarship to continuously enhance the Faculty's reputation and performance;
- ensure the effective management of the financial, people, physical and technological resources of the Faculty (including its cognate Departments and Centres) <https://www.eduhk.hk/fhm/en/page/homepage> to achieve the University's strategic and academic goals;
- monitor the performance outcomes of the Faculty within the framework of the quality assurance policies and systems of the University; and
- initiate and develop effective local, national, regional and international collaborative relationships with relevant professional associations, the Education Bureau, schools, universities and other education providers and research institutes, as well as driving knowledge transfer initiatives.

Applicants should have a doctoral degree in an area relevant to Humanities, a distinguished, internationally-recognized record of research and scholarship, a proven record of outstanding academic leadership in tertiary institutions, including the management of human and financial resources, budgeting and external networking. The appointee must demonstrate a commitment to leading research and pioneering cutting-edge developments in the relevant disciplines, and possess strong communication and networking skills to rally the support of internal and external stakeholders for the benefit of the Faculty and the University. A good knowledge of local higher education scene and appreciation of the challenges of working in a multicultural context will be an advantage.

The successful candidate will be appointed as Chair Professor / Professor or carry an equivalent status commensurate with his / her qualifications and experience, and hold a concurrent appointment as Dean of the Faculty of Humanities. Remuneration package will be highly competitive and attractive fringe benefits will be offered.
