Speaker: Hillary YIP

Founder & CEO, MinorMynas



Hillary Yip, at only 14 years of age, is the Founder and CEO of MinorMynas app, which is designed for connecting children to learn from each other. Since the age of 10, Hillary has been invited to share her insights in different occasions, such as APCAC Business Summit 2019, Yidan Prize Summit, Jumperstarter, and other sessions hosted by universities and corporates (e.g. Microsoft Corporation and Apple Inc.). She was also invited to deliver a speech about her learning journey in TEDx. As a young entrepreneur, Hillary has been featured by a number of international media outlets, including YIT, South China Morning Post, BBC and CCTV, etc. Her entrepreneurial story is known around the world, and has attracted a large number of users to MinorMynas.

Co-Founder, NEX Team Inc



After graduating with a math degree from CUHK, Philip received a full scholarship to pursue a master's degree at the University of British Columbia (Vancouver, Canada). After graduation, he moved to Silicon Valley and worked for Microsoft and Apple as an Engineering Manager. In 2017, he founded NEX Team Inc with three other co-founders who were all born and raised in Hong Kong.

HomeCourt is the first mobile AI application created by Nex Team Inc, and is the world's first AI-powered basketball training application. The team raised USD 4M within 1 year, with investors including Mark Cuban, two-time NBA MVP and Hall of Famer Steve Nash, NBA Star Jeremy Lin, and many others.

Since launching in June 2018, HomeCourt generated huge interest in the basketball community. The app was covered by Wall Street Journal, Forbes, TechCrunch, and its advanced mobile AI technologies was also demonstrated on stage in the 2018 Apple's iPhone event. In only 9 months since launching on App Store, the app has tracked over 10M shots, and is used by users in more than 150 countries and across 5,000 cities.

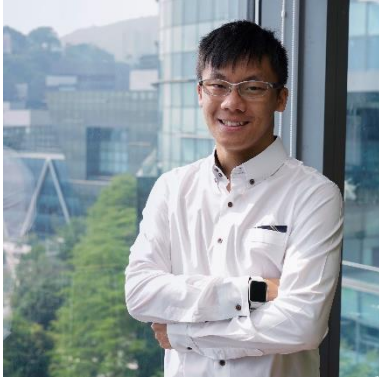
Sharing Topic: “Follow My Heart: Journey from Hong Kong to Silicon Valley ”

"Son of the Star" of Hong Kong



Mr. Stark Chan is a young entrepreneur in Hong Kong. In 2004, he achieved the Second Award in Engineering Category of the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair for his invention, Total Equip, a domestic security robot modelled after R2-D2. As an honor, an asteroid was named after him as "20780 Chanyikhei" by LINEAR under the Ceres Connection program. Also, he was invited by the California Institute of Technology to NASA (MESUR Pathfinder), thus he was later widely recognized as "Son of the Star". In 2011, Mr. Chan founded his Bull.B Tech which focus on bringing creative ideas in any digital marketing solution and implanting latest technology for iOS and Android application. In 2012, he won "HKCS Outstanding ICT Achiever Award", "Hong Kong ICT Award" and "Best Startup Business Award". In 2016, he was awarded Bronze Bauhinia Star (BBS) by the Hong Kong Government.

Mr. Rex Sham is the Co-Founder and Chief Science Officer of Insight Robotics where he is responsible for the company's technology and innovation strategy. He has prototyped hardware and software solutions for the company's current core technologies, as well as developed two co-authored patents and won various research and development awards for his inventions. With expertise in robotics and artificial intelligence, Mr. Sham is committed to creating automated solutions to derive intelligent and actionable insights from data. He leads his R&D team in the development of ForestScan, a robot that works outdoors 24x7, monitoring the occurrence of Forest fires in 46 cities all over the world. He also leads the team in developing a unique software platform that allows drone operators to check, process and share aerial survey information on the cloud.
