## General Admission Requirements

- The Programme accepts applicants who fulfil the following entrance requirements:
  - Applicants holding a recognised post-secondary qualification such as an Associate Degree / Higher Diploma, preferably in early childhood studies or related discipline; or
  - Transfer students who have completed at least two years of study of a 4-year full time degree programme in a recognised institution, preferably in early childhood studies or related discipline; or
  - Mature applicants (aged 25 or above on 31 August of the year in which applicants commence their studies) who have specific talents, achievements or a wealth of relevant experience; or
  - Other equivalent qualifications to be assessed on an individual basis
- Final-year students of recognised local Associate Degree/ Higher Diploma programmes can also apply. Selected applicants are required to successfully complete the relevant Associate Degree / Higher Diploma programmes and with good GPA
- In addition, applicants must demonstrate an acceptable level of proficiency in English language, unless exempted by the University. Priority will be given to applicants who have obtained Level 3 in HKDSE English Language or the equivalent<sup>+</sup>
- Applicants are also required to have satisfactory performance in the admission interview and/or test

<sup>+</sup> The following public examination results are recognised as equivalent to Level 3 of HKDSE English Language:

- A TOEFL score of 550 (paper-based) or 80 (Internet-based) or above; or
- A score of 6 or above in International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Academic Level; or

- Grade C or above in GCSE English or English Literature; or
- Grade E or above in GCE AS Level or AL Level English; or

Graduates may continue their professional development through postgraduate studies and extend their career horizons to academic/teaching professionals, occupational therapists, speech-language pathologists, social workers, arts or expressive therapist, job placement specialists or consultants in the field of inclusive and special education.

Remarks: The BA(SE) programme helps students pursue careers related to education and human services. Completion of the Programme will not lead to Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) in Hong Kong. Upon graduation, students interested in pursuing professional teacher training may apply for a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) or programmes granting a QTS qualification.



- Chinese as the Medium of Instruction [CMI] - The medium of instruction is mainly Chinese. English will be adopted as the language of instruction for specific courses, as deemed appropriate
- English as the Medium of Instruction [EMI] - The medium of instruction is mainly English

Students will be given the opportunity to choose either the CMI or the EMI stream upon admission to the Programme. The final allocation of students to the CMI or EMI stream will be decided by the University.


