SENIOR YEAR *Admissions*

We offer a number of Senior Year (SY) places for graduates of sub-degree programmes. Quality students holding recognised post-secondary qualifications or attending the final year of a recognised sub-degree programme (such as AD/HD or equivalent) will be considered for Senior Year admissions.

They will be admitted based on the credit transfer system and can complete their programme in two years. The SY student population is growing and our Faculty has provided various kinds of support to cater to their unique learning needs.

GENERAL ENTRANCE *Requirements*

Associate Degree/Higher Diploma Final Year Students or Graduates

- Associate Degree or Higher Diploma qualification awarded by recognised institutions with a good GPA.
- Final year of a recognised Associate Degree / Higher Diploma programme or equivalent[^] (subject to successful completion of the programme by August with a good GPA) are welcome to apply.

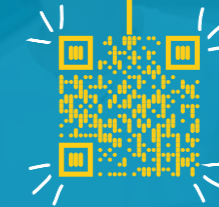

Transfer Students

Applicants who are currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or higher degree programme at a recognised local or non-local[#] university will be considered on an individual basis. Repeating of UGC-funded study across institutions* is generally discouraged except under exceptional circumstances.

* The following institutions (and the EdUHK) are UGC-funded institutions: City University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University, Lingnan University, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology and The University of Hong Kong.

[#] Applicants holding non-local post-secondary qualifications may be required to provide a "Report for Qualifications Assessment" issued by the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) to support their applications.

Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Digital Chinese Culture and Communication

數碼中國文化與傳意榮譽文學士

賦能創意：通過數位創新掌握中文語言與文化

本課程結合媒體、創意藝術和數碼素養元素，為學生提供廣泛多元的中文語言與文化科目，務求使畢業生兼具綜合知識和專業形象，為文化、藝術、商業或經濟領域，例如創意產業、旅遊及零售業、知識產權服務等作出貢獻。透過修讀本課程，學生將獲得應用數碼工具在語言應用中的實際操作經驗，賦予他們具備開發、製作及發佈創新語言學習和教學的創意數碼內容，以及為中文傳訊領域應用工具的能力。

課程目的

本課程旨在培養學生具備中國語言與文化能力，同時強調媒體與數碼素養。透過全面而廣泛的課程讓學生獲得紮實的專業基礎，為文化藝術和商業經濟領域培養人才。此外，學生將有機會在大灣區實習，應用所學知識與技能，開發數碼內容，運用於語言學習與教學，同時也能在不同的媒體平台上創作並發布具有新意且引人入勝的作品。



實習

學生須在第三學年的暑期或第四學年第一學期必須參加實習課(3學分)。實習旨在讓學生於實際生活環境整合和應用學習所得的知識，從而迎接現實工作環境的挑戰，並思考未來就業方向的機會。

中文專修組別

高年級入學可用中文專修組別之15 學分 (5門科目) 提升其中國語文，文學 及文化知識。完成後可獲教育局語文教育及研究常務委員會 (語常會) 認證取得主修語文科目的學位課程資歷，畢業生可另行報考本地教育文憑以取得教師資格。(有待香港教育局語常會最終審批)

Be More Than Good at English

The BA(ESDC) programme aims to cultivate a new generation of English studies students with strong digital literacy skills through a digitally enriched curriculum. It provides a wide range of courses to build a solid foundation in English language, linguistics and digital literacy, consolidated by hands-on experience in using digital tools for language applications.

Students will be empowered to develop digital contents for the learning and teaching of languages, to publish in digital media and to support and critically evaluate digital communication solutions. A combination of English studies and digital communication technology will allow students to further contribute to the transformation of education, media, and publishing in the digital age.

PROGRAMME Features

- To cultivate a new generation of English Studies students with strong digital literacy skills through a digitally enriched curriculum;
- All-round training in digital communication;
- Solid foundation in English language, linguistics and digital literacy, consolidated by hands-on experience in using digital tools for language applications; and
- An "English Language Strand" will be offered to Senior Year entrants from 2027/28 intake cohort and onwards. Upon completion of this Strand, students will be recognised by the Standing Committee on Language Education and Research (SCOLAR) as graduates of an English-major degree.



INTERNSHIP

Students are required to participate in a compulsory internship (3 cps) in the summer after Year 3. The Internship aims to enable students to integrate and apply in real-life settings the knowledge and skills gained in their studies.

The Internship also prepares students to handle challenges they may encounter in real work situations and provides opportunities for them to consider their future career directions.

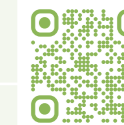
CAREER Prospects

Teaching Chinese as a Second Language

Journey to Become a Chinese Teacher to Non-Chinese Speakers

The BA(TCSL) programme aims to nurture professionals in teaching Chinese as a Second Language. Students enrolled in this programme will be equipped with:

- Interdisciplinary knowledge including Chinese language and pedagogy, as well as educational psychology; and
- The ability to analyse issues related to Chinese teaching in the context of multilingualism and globalisation.

FACULTY OF HUMANITIES

PROGRAMME Features

- The first and only undergraduate programme in Hong Kong specialising in Teaching Chinese as a Second Language;
- A "Chinese Language Strand" is offered to Senior Year entrants. Upon completion of this strand, students will be recognised by the Standing Committee on Language Education and Research (SCOLAR) as graduates of a Chinese major degree; and
- Graduates can further apply for local Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) programmes.



FIELD Experience

Students are required to participate in the Field Experience in their Semester 2, Year 3. The Field Experience consists of (1) local school visits; and (2) a 4-week Field Experience (tentatively during May - June) in the international college of a non-local university. It aims to help students develop a comprehensive understanding of teaching Chinese as a second language through a range of structured activities from school visits to block practice in multicultural educational settings.
