EDUHK SUMMER SCHOOL 2026

The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) is a publicly funded tertiary institution dedicated to the advancement of learning and teaching, through a diverse offering of academic and research programmes on teacher education and complementary social sciences and humanities disciplines. EdUHK is ranked 4th in Asia and 12th in the QS World University Rankings by Subject (Education) for 2025.

The **EdUHK Summer School** provides learning opportunities for non-local students from partner institutions worldwide. This intensive programme allows students to enrol in two academic courses (each carries three credits) across various academic areas. Students will have the chance to study with peers from around the globe on EdUHK's vibrant campus and participate in excursions, activities, and visits to immerse themselves in local Hong Kong culture.

Medium of Instruction : All teaching and assessments are conducted in English, unless otherwise specified in the course descriptions

Tuition : Waived

Accommodation :

- Double or triple occupancy rooms on campus are guaranteed for EdUHK Summer School participants
- Accommodation Fee Waived

Transcript : A transcript indicating the medium of instruction for teaching and assessment, the duration of the programme and the course(s) the student has completed will be sent to home institution in October 2026





ELIGIBILITY

Nomination by Home Institutions :

Interested students must be nominated by EdUHK's partner institutions to be eligible for a place in the programme

Academic Requirements :

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 on a 4.33 scale; or
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale; or equivalent

English Proficiency for Non-native English Speakers :

- TOEFL: 550 (paper-based) / 80 (internet-based); or
- IELTS: Minimum overall band of 6 in the academic version; or
- Alternatively, a letter or signed declaration from the home institution's International Office certifying English proficiency

A call for nominations from Partner Institutions will be announced in Jan 2026.

The deadline for submissions is **February 2026**.
