[#] EdUHK is one of the teacher education providers in Hong Kong. Graduates of the University's teacher education programmes are eligible to apply to become fully qualified Registered Teachers. For registration as a teacher, graduates should approach the Teacher Registration Team of the Education Bureau (EDB) to submit applications directly.

[^] Students admitted into this programme are normally assigned a focus of study (i.e. primary or secondary level) by the end of their first year of study. The focus of study will be reflected in the arrangements for their Field Experience and adopted for the purpose of application for Qualified Teacher Status in Hong Kong upon graduation. This programme is designed to provide students with the disciplinary and professional competency to teach in both primary and secondary schools. However, recognition of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) in primary or secondary schools in Hong Kong is subject to the decision of the Education Bureau (EDB). Graduates of this programme are required to approach the Teacher Registration Team of the EDB to submit applications directly and that all applications will be assessed by the EDB.

¹ Students should have possessed a good command of Chinese (including Cantonese / Putonghua).

² Most of the Major courses will be taught in Cantonese (supplemented by English and Putonghua).

³ Applicants should possess a certain level of skills in different sports, including athletics, ball games, gymnastics, swimming, racket games and dance, etc.

⁴ Applicants must be able to communicate effectively and fluently in Cantonese and English.

Application Procedures & Timeline*

1. Submit application with supporting documents[^], such as academic qualifications, language results, recommendations, awards, personal statement, etc., via www.eduhk.hk/acadprog/online/
2. December 2025 – May 2026: Attend online admission interviews and/or practical tests (for shortlisted applicants)
3. December 2025 – May 2026: Receive and accept admission offer (if any)
4. September 2026: Semester I commences

Application Deadline[#]

- Early Round Application: 17 November 2025
- Main Round Application: 7 January 2026
- Late round Application: 6 May 2026

General Entrance Requirements*

American-Patterned Education

High School Graduation Diploma with one of the following:

- SAT Reasoning Test: A minimum total score of 1,190 (out of 1,600) in the new SAT Reasoning Test (including Evidence-Based Reading and Writing, and Mathematics) / 1,650 (out of 2,400) in the old SAT Reasoning Test (including Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics) in one sitting
- ACT: Composite score of 24 or above
- AP: Grade 3 in two AP subjects

British-Patterned Education

- GCE Advanced Level / International Advanced Level: Grade D or above in 3 AL subjects; or Grade D in 2 AL plus 2 ASL subjects (*Not including Chinese / Mandarin / English Language subjects. The same subject cannot be counted at both the AL and ASL*)
- BTEC: BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma; or BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC); or BTEC Higher National Diplomas (HND)
