- Day 4 Travel from Cambridge to Oxford (visit Christ Church, Bodleian Library, Oxford Botanic Garden, Bicester Village)

- Day 6 Visit Stonehenge

Application

- Application deadline: 18 July 2025 (Fri)
- Quota: 20
- Shortlisted students will be invited to the interview between the **last week of July** and
- Successful students will be notified by email between TBC, and to settle the payment by **early August 2025**.
- **Early August:** Submission of bank receipt, student undertaking and passport page
- **Mid-Nov to mid-Dec:** Pre-trip meetings

*e.g. For UG students:

If you have never use GLEF, you have 50% subsidy, and you will need to pay \$14,990.

If you have received \$4,000 subsidy from GLEF before, you will only have \$6,000 left from this GLEF subsidy. That is, you will need to pay \$18,990.

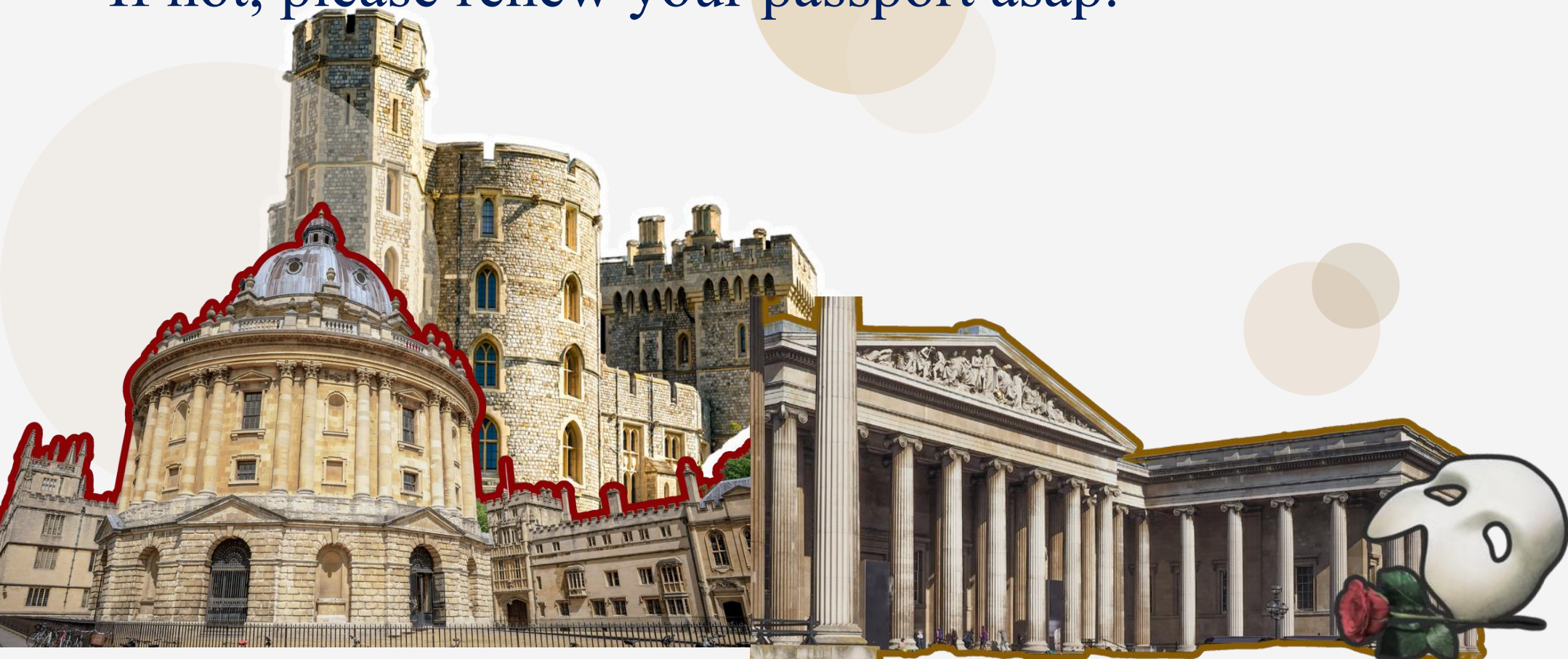
For HD (ECE) students: You have \$5,000 subsidy from GLEF, you will need to pay \$19,990.

The selection criteria

- 1st priority will be given to those who have not yet had international education experience during their studies at the University
- 2nd priority will be given to those who have not received the GLEF subsidy before

Important Note

 - It costs £16 to apply for one through the UK ETA app or the GOV.UK website.
 - Make sure your passport is valid for 6 months beyond 14 Dec 2025.

General about the UK

Winter: December to February

UK Weather in December: December marks the start of winter, with temperatures averaging between 1°C and 8°C. Expect chilly days and occasional snowfall.
