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ETS, Dr. von Davier was the Research Center Director of the Global Psychometric Services (GPS) Center and of the Psychometric, Development and Resources (PDR) Center. The GPS center supports the psychometric work for all large ETS international programs, such as TOEFL iBT and TOEIC. The PDR center supported the efforts of the ETS Global Division to expand into new markets through responding to bids and submitting proposals. She was a co-author on a book on the kernel method of test equating and a guest co-editor for a special issue on population invariance of linking functions for *Applied Psychological Measurement*. She edited a volume on new models for test equating and authored a book on testing causal hypotheses. She published research articles in several leading psychometrics journals. Her interests also include test linking methods, estimation methods for item response models, and models for measuring growth. Prior to working for ETS, she worked in Germany at the Universities of Trier, Magdeburg, Kiel, and Jena, and the ZUMA in Mannheim. She also worked at the Institute of Psychology of the Romanian Academy, and was a visiting scholar at the Stockholm School of Economics.
