## **Global Hong Kong Ambassador Programme**

### **Objective**

Funded by the University Grants Committee (UGC), the “Global Hong Kong Ambassador Programme” aims at training EdUHK undergraduate students as Ambassadors for promoting integration of students from all backgrounds and origins.

### **Eligibility**

Undergraduate UGC-funded students NOT graduating in 2021 are welcome.

### **Programme structure**

#### **Stage (I): Attending a FREE 3-day-2-night intensive learning camp (10-12 August 2021)**

- Topic 1
  - Lecture on “Hong Kong as a Global Migrant Society”: exploring Hong Kong’s legacy as a meeting place for Chinese and non-Chinese.
  - Walking tour on “Hong Kong Ethnic Diversity”: visiting the cemeteries in Wanchai, experiencing the stories of different ethnicities including Chinese, Europeans, Indians, Parsees and Jews in Hong Kong.
- Topic 2
  - Lecture on “Hong Kong as a Global Economic Center”: exploring the economic development of Hong Kong in the context of global cities.
  - Walking tour on “Hong Kong as a Global City”: walking through the old and new sites from Sheung Wan to Central, experiencing the trajectory of Hong Kong from a global Chinese center to an international financial center.
- Topic 3
  - Lecture on “Hong Kong as a Global Cultural Melting-pot”: exploring Hong Kong’s cultural hybridity and plurality such as religion and food.
  - Tasting tour on “Hong Kong Food Culture”: tasting food and cuisines of different cultures in Yau Ma Tei, e.g. Cha Chaan Teng, Indian curry.

#### **Stage (II): Serving as ambassadors to organize TWO activities for promoting integration of students from all backgrounds and origins (throughout Semesters I & II, 2021-2022)**

Undergraduate students trained as Ambassadors through Stage (I) will be required to organize themselves into three teams to self-initiate TWO activities that target at both local undergraduate students and inbound exchange/non-local students. Under the guidance of SAO officers, substantial budget will be allocated to each team for organizing the activities. The Ambassadors will be encouraged to collaborate with inbound exchange/non-local students and student societies in the planning and implementation of their activities.

#### **Stage (III): Graduation ceremony (April 2022)**

All Ambassadors will be required to attend a graduation ceremony cum report-back session to share their participation in this programme including the self-initiated activities in Stage 2. Ambassadors who have satisfactorily completed both Stages (I) and (II) will be presented with commendation letters and graduation certificates in recognition of their contribution as Ambassadors.
