Global elements to be incorporated

- 1. Involves faculty and students from the Americas, Mainland China and Hong Kong;
- 2. Connects participants' experiences with two major global sustainability points of debate: diversity and complexity;
- 3. Includes global case studies, developed by the participating international faculty members;
- 4. Involves five real-time student-led UN-like Meetings of the Parties, via videoconferencing;
- 5. The global scope of this course initiates collective on-line and Moodle forum conversations about global sustainability among students from the participating universities.
