Context of the project (1)

Leningrad region

- Territory 83 900 km2.
- Population 1 778 85 man.
- Size: the length from West to East 500 km, from North to South – 320 km.
- Bordered by the countries of the European Union: Finland and Estonia.

Context of the project (2)

- Leningrad region includes 16 municipalities;
- 11 cities with population more than 10,000 people.



Learning region

The research project involves two stages:
1. The pilot phase - 2 years.
2. Large-scale implementation of the project - 5-6 years.

Cities' selection for the pilot project: Learning region

The pilot project will include two cities from the Leningrad region; the population of the cities have to be more than 10 000 people:

(A) An industrial profile of the city;

(B) An agricultural industrial profile of the city

The pilot project, 1st Step.

• The presentation of the pilot project to the administration of the Leningrad region;

An approval of the project and its financing.

The pilot project, 2nd Step. Socio-Demographic characteristics of the two cities

• Analysis of social and demographic structure of the population* (analysis of the current situation and a forecast for the next five years): age and gender, professional and educational structure of the population, household income and others.

*A statistical method to be used.

The pilot project, 2nd Step.

Socio-demographic Matrix (of the two cities)

 Analysis of employment patterns and rate of unemployment (analysis of current situation and prognosis for the next five years):
 in the context of the age groups and occupational composition.

The pilot project, 3rd Step.

• The analysis of the employed and the unemployed population's readiness for the lifelong learning (individual social and demographic groups).

The analysis of the readiness of a government, civil society organizations, small and medium businesses to promote and participate in the pilot project.

The pilot project, 4th Step.

Educational and Cultural characteristics of the two cities

• An analysis of the socio-cultural and educational infrastructure of the two cities (analysis of the current situation and a forecast for the next five years)

The pilot project, 5th Step.

- The generalization of results and formulation of a project for each city "The Learning City (name of the city) of the Leningrad region ".
- Propose formulated projects for the administration of the Leningrad region and the administrations of the two cities for implementation.
