9 figures support the fame of Learning City Model

- 1.17 years' promoting reading among citizens by organizing "Reading Month" while taking "Let's have our city be respected because of loving reading" (让城 市因为热爱读书而受人尊重) as one of the ten Shenzhen Concepts
- 2.26 years' ranking the national 1st in buying books per citizen
- 3.24 Hour Book Bar in doors for 10 years time







9 figures support the fame of Learning City Model

- 24 books is the average reading amount for children in the city
- 5. Over 1 hour is the average reading time for each citizen
- 6. Every 10 thousand citizen have one library in the city
- 4 book malls and bookstores are located all over the city
- More than a hundred civic reading organizations have kept on driving the reading campaign in the city
- 9. Have 119 reading promoters for the reading campaign

- Every district has established its own national or provincial level community further education demonstration sites.
- 2. There exist 69 community colleges and over 200 community schools.

- 140 Shenzhen Municipal Learning Community have been assessed and titled
