***Governance and Financing of Lifelong Learning:
A Policy Perspective from the Asia and Pacific Region***

Abstract:

The keynote addresses the current situation of lifelong learning in terms of access and participation in countries of Asia and Pacific region. It analyzes governance, policy frameworks, legislation, financial modalities, and delivery mechanisms as well as division of roles within the government and amongst key players. Issues regarding quality assurance and monitoring and evaluation on lifelong learning will be also addressed. In addition, and by showing various cases and data in the region, the keynote also identifies areas where more researches and studies are required for policy recommendations. Finally, initiatives and analytic researches of UNESCO Asia and Pacific Regional Bureau for Education with other partners will also be presented.
