

## Research Assistant I (Ref: RAI/PS/0620a) **Department of Psychology**

The appointee will be responsible for running a project on language and literacy development. Specific duties include preparing testing materials, contacting kindergarten and primary schools, recruiting participants, collecting data, literature review, data analysis, and drafting research reports. He/she is also expected to perform administrative support to the research team. The appointment will be for 12-month starting from Aug/Sep 2020 with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Psychology or a related discipline. They should be proficient in both Cantonese, Mandarin, and English; have strong coordination, organization, and planning skills; be passionate to work with children in school settings. Experience in programming skills (computerize the tests) and proficient in statistical analysis (e.g., MPlus, R studio) is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
